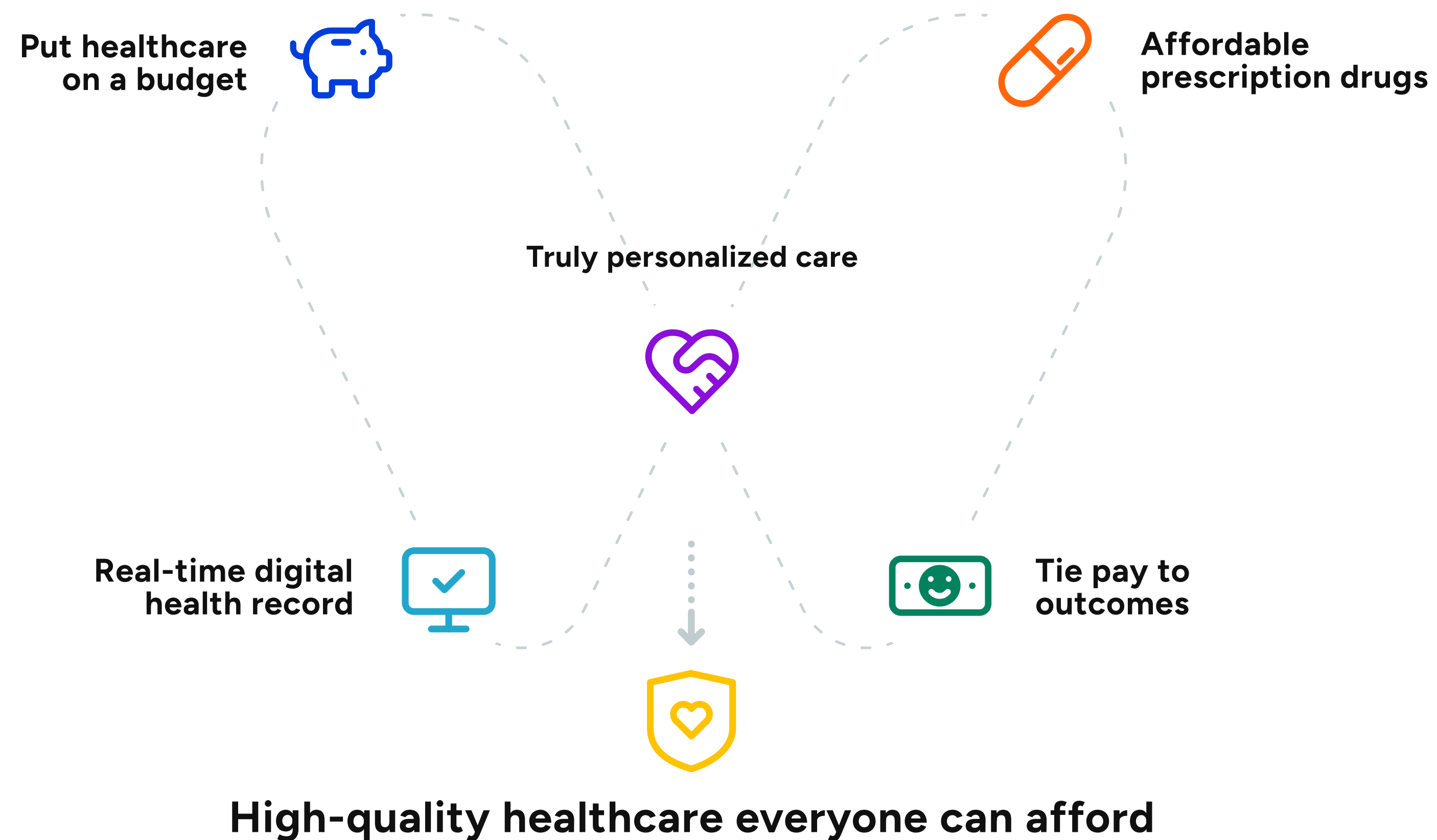

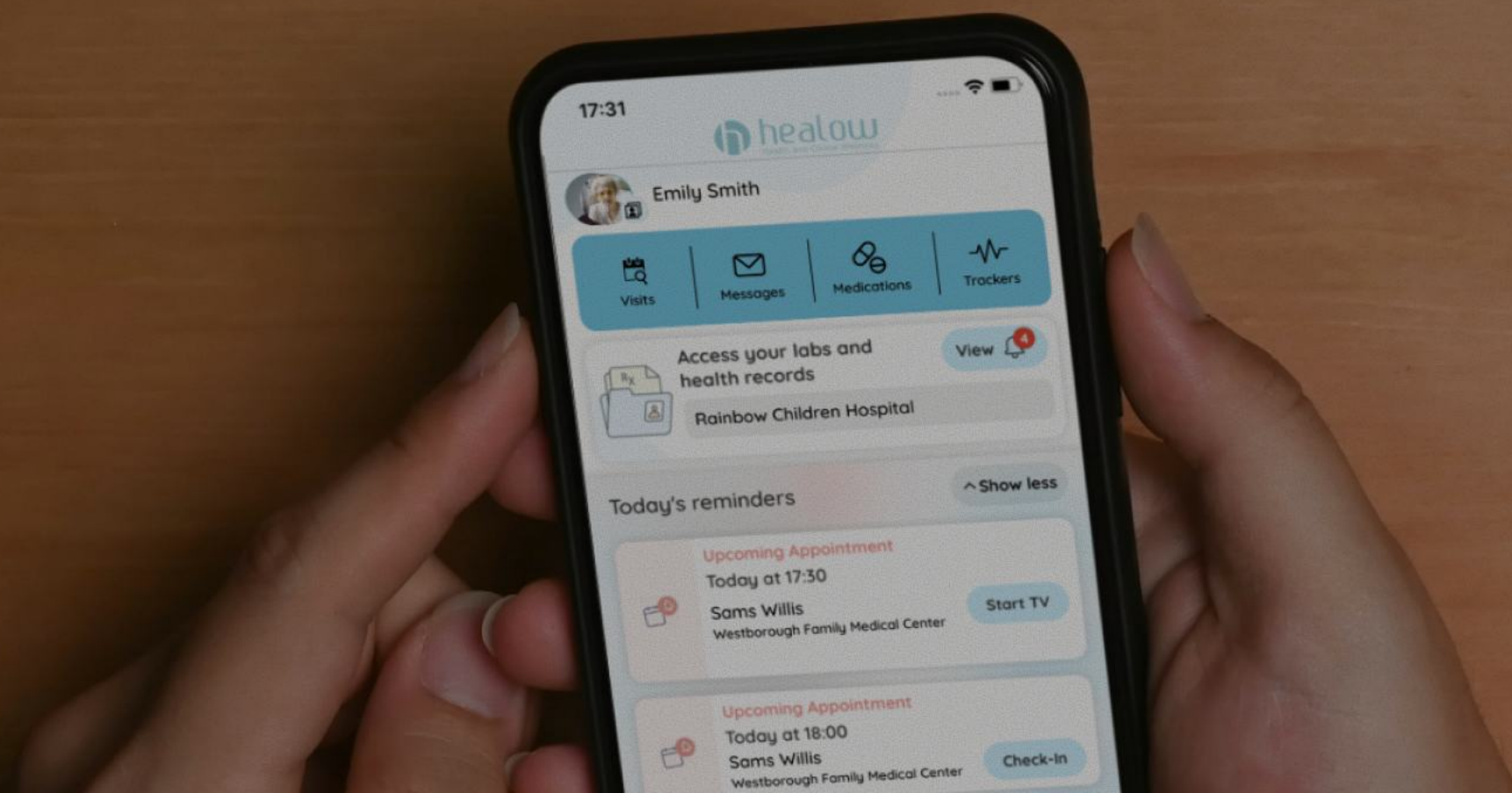
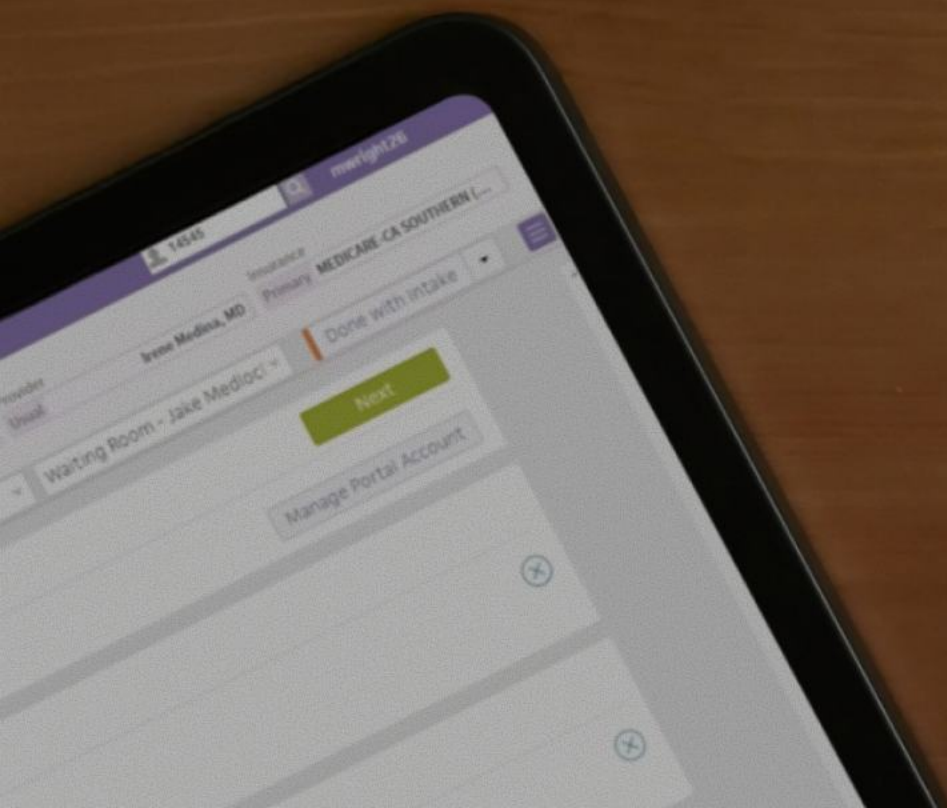
The Worthy vision

The problem

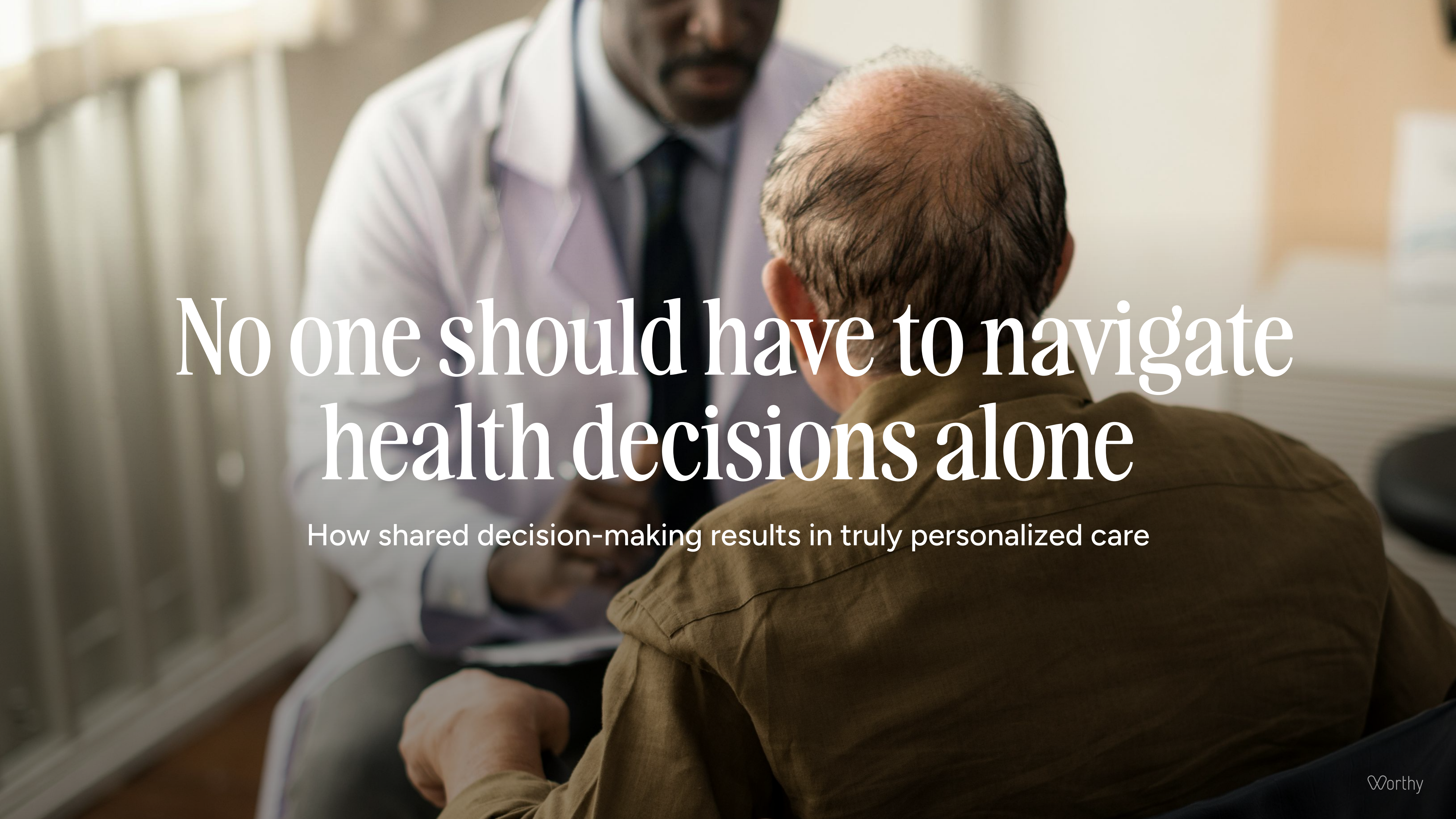

The problem

- It can take a long time to get an accurate diagnosis and sometimes that initial diagnosis is wrong
- Physicians and patients are often working from incomplete, even different information
- You don't know what treatment options exist and if they would be successful for you
- The process of ensuring your health plan will pay for treatment can be uncertain and stressful



Worthy solution

- **Together, you and your physician(s) decide on the best treatment based on timely, complete information**
- AI can assist physicians and patients to ensure a timely and accurate diagnosis

Improving health and lowering costs by tying healthcare payment to outcomes



The problem

- Providers usually get paid more for doing more, expensive treatments rather than for improving patients' health
- Financial incentives can influence treatment decisions in ways that don't serve patient health
- The system needs to ensure everyone on your care team is motivated by your health outcomes, not other factors



Worthy solution

- **Remove conflicts of interest - providers get rewarded when you're healthier, not for prescribing expensive treatments or denying care**
- Everyone is on your team, and work together to make you healthier

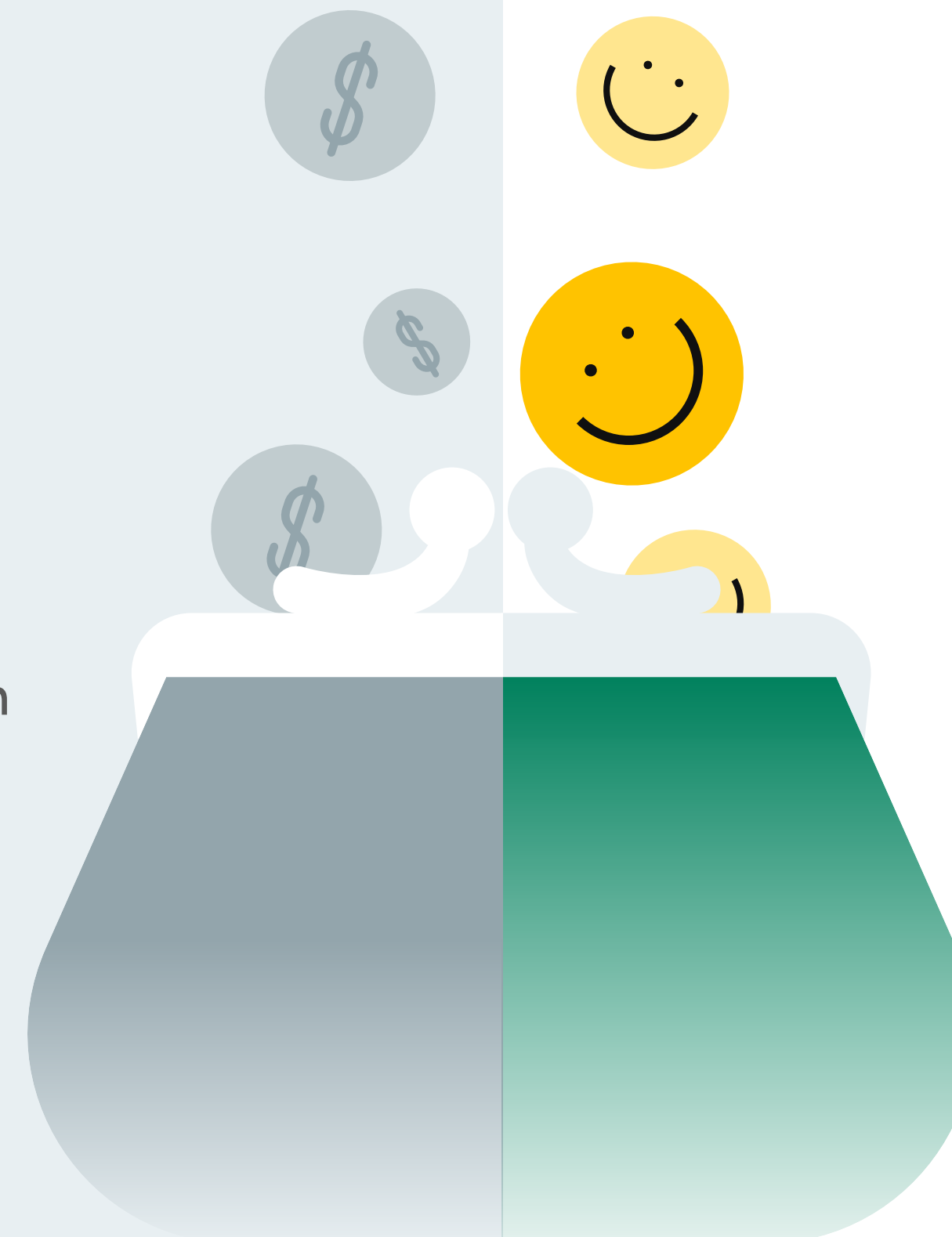

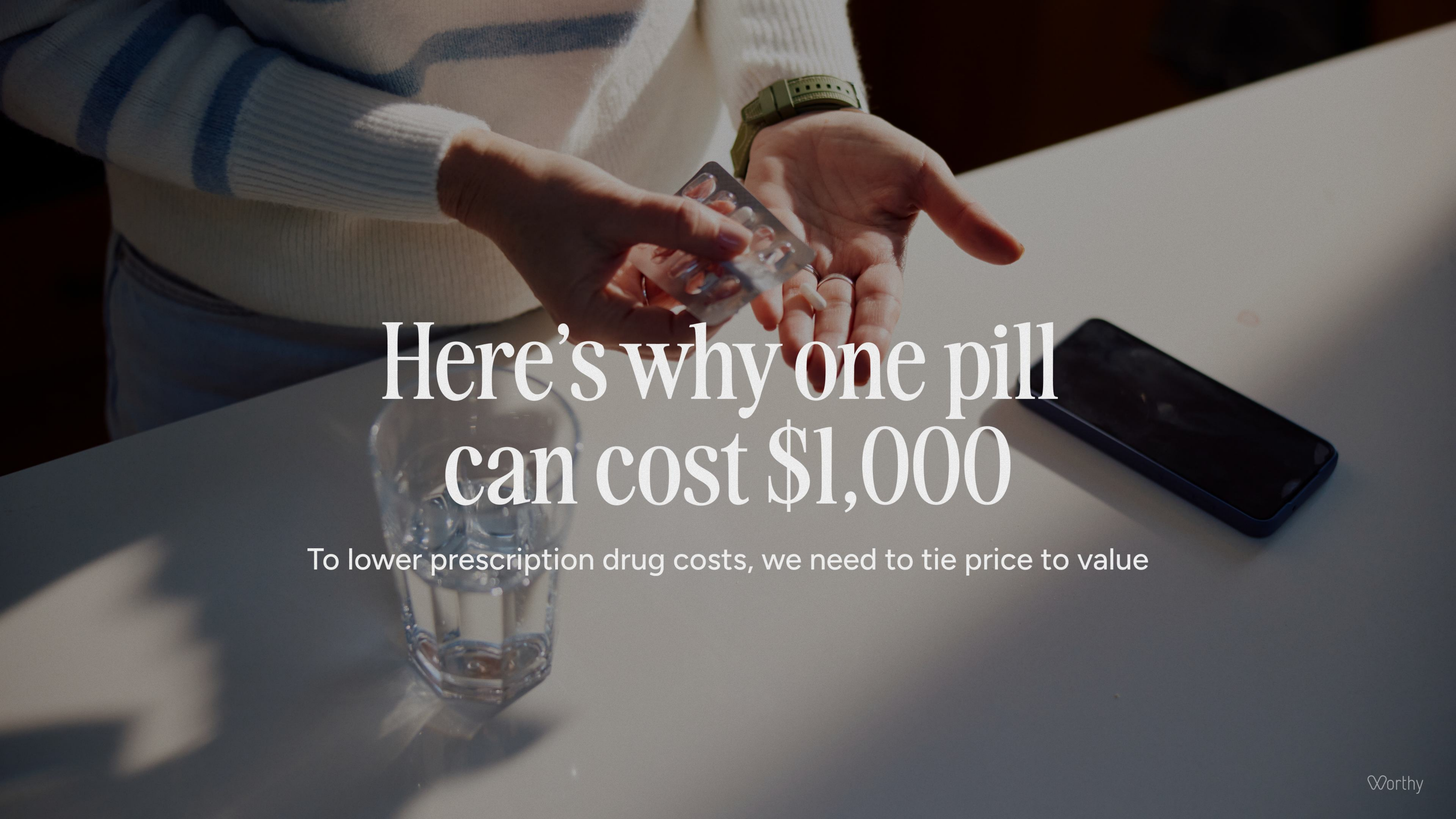

To lower prescription drug costs, we need to tie price to value



The problem

- Everyone in the drug chain gets commission on price, and this creates incentives to choose more expensive options
- Breakthrough drugs are sometimes priced beyond what their actual health benefits justify
- The system rewards higher prices rather than better outcomes throughout the entire distribution chain



Worthy solution

- **Eliminate pay tied to drug prices or volumes**
- Pay for the patient getting the right drug at the right time for the right price
- Create a process to ensure new drugs are priced commensurate with their value

Healthcare everyone can afford

Coverage should be affordable. The industry needs to go on a budget.



The problem

- Healthcare is too expensive and when it becomes more efficient, savings don't automatically revert back to better prices for patients
- People who don't actively select insurance end up uninsured because coverage isn't the default



Worthy solution

- **Put healthcare on a budget and ensure savings return to patients**
- Make premiums and out-of-pocket costs affordable by capping percentage of income paid for healthcare
- Default health plan for all with automatic enrollment with the ability to opt out

Create a National Office of Health Care Affordability with the power to set and enforce budgets

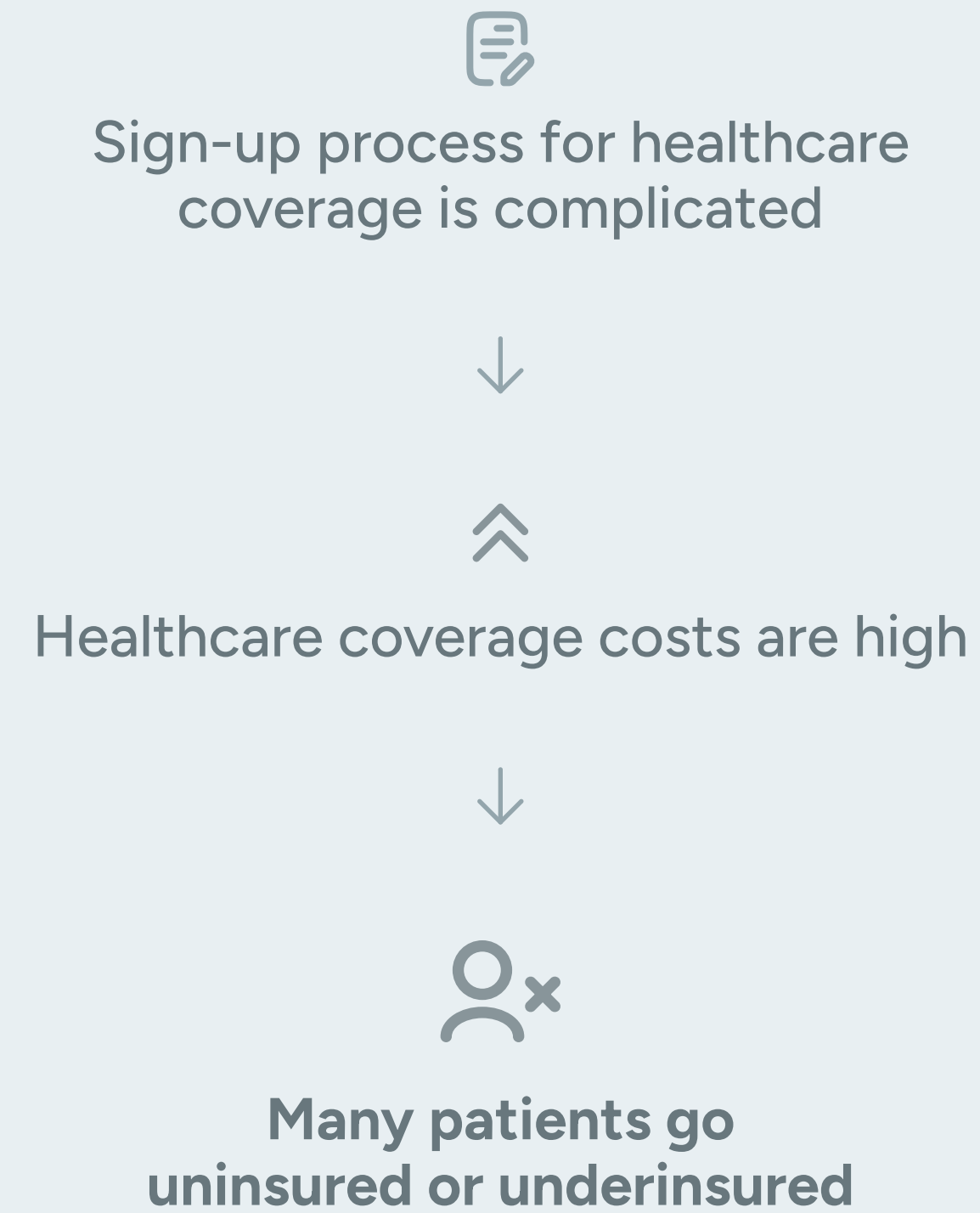


Set budgets that keep future healthcare cost increases at or below general price and wage increases every year

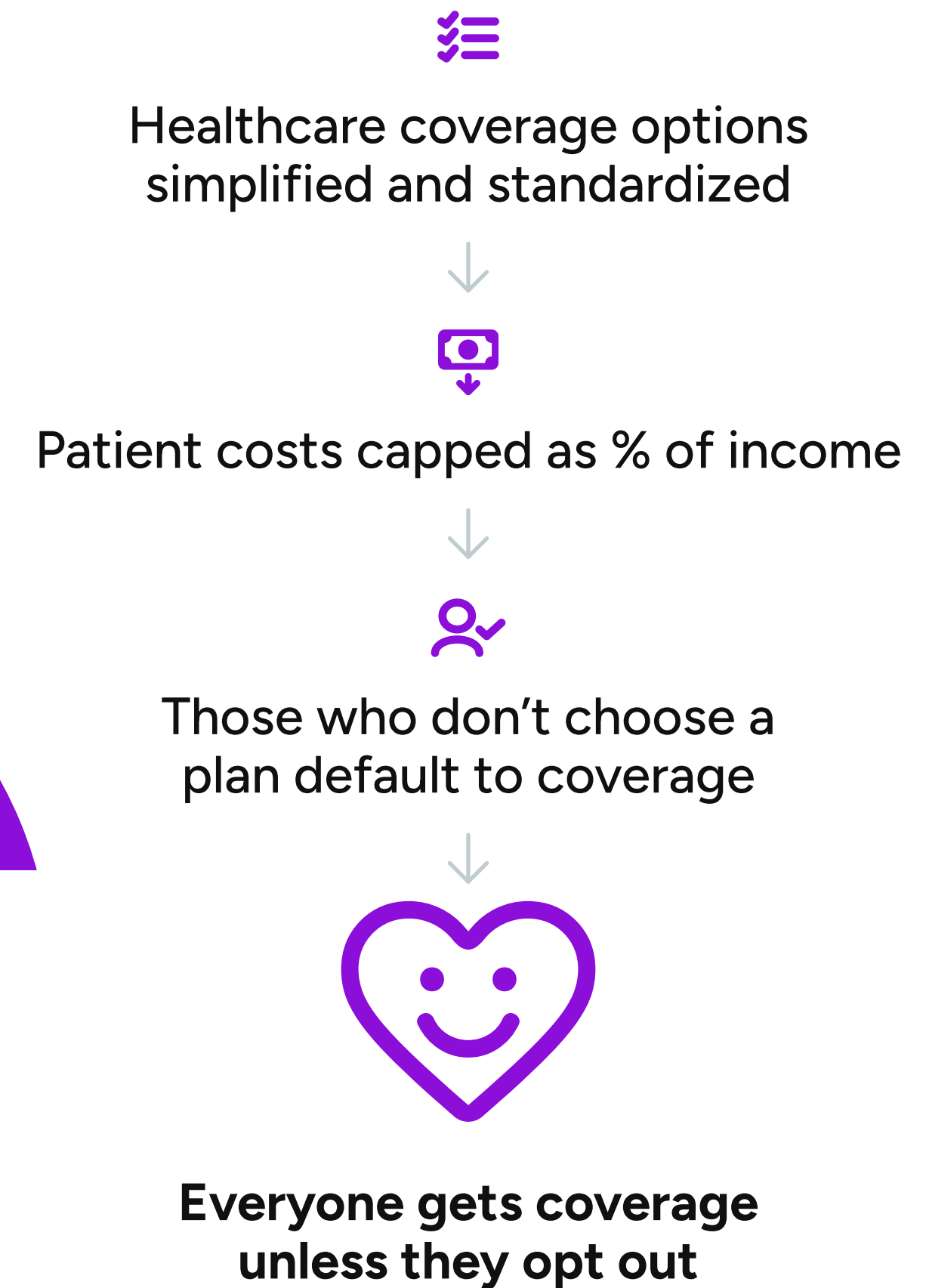


Enforce the budgets so healthcare costs trend downward
